You (m/f/x) will represent the field of Business Information Systems in research and teaching. Your tasks include offering courses in the Bachelor, Master and Diploma programs of the Faculty of Business and Economics. We expect active collaboration within the Faculty of Business and Economics as well as interdisciplinary cooperation within the university. The acquisition of external funding is also expected. Your willingness to teach in English is a prerequisite, as is your willingness to actively participate in academic self-administration.

You have an excellent PhD (or equivalent) in Wirtschaftsinformatik (WI) or Information Systems (IS) or in a related field and a background in the subject area of Advanced Analytics (i.e. analytics including machine learning and other artificial intelligence [Al]-based approaches and techniques). You can demonstrate your outstanding and relevant academic achievements in the above-mentioned area through regular presentations of research results at international WI/IS conferences, as well as through the quality and quantity of your publications in high-ranking international WI/IS journals and proceedings. In accordance with the profile of the Faculty of Business and Economics and the Business Information Systems Group, an application-oriented research focus with the potential for theory development is envisaged. In particular, a research profile focusing on the design of the "next generation" of intelligent systems and services and their integration into the socio-technical structure of companies is desired. Such systems and services use approaches and techniques from the field of Advanced Analytics as well as large amounts of data to transform established business processes or traditional business models. An additional domain-specific focus in an area that can be assigned to one of the research priority areas of TUD is an advantage. Good teaching skills and relevant teaching experience are a prerequisite for appointment, as is the ability and willingness to offer courses in English. Candidates who do not speak German are also welcome to apply. In this case, we expect them to acquire sufficient German language skills to take on teaching and self-administration tasks within two years of appointment. In addition, we expect experience in acquiring external funding and managing corresponding research projects. We are looking for a scholar who is internationally recognized in the field and who has an interdisciplinary and international network. In addition to the general requirements under employment law, applicants must fulfil the employment qualification

requirements of § 59 of the Institutions of Higher Education Act in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSG).
