We are looking for a motivated research assistant to support our research activities within the CeTI Cluster of Excellence (Centre for Tactile Internet with Human-in-the-Loop) at TUD. The position offers the opportunity to gain hands-on experience in psychological research, including the organization of studies, conducting experiments, and supporting dissemination activities, while working in a friendly and collaborative environment.

Tasks:

- preparation of experimental materials (e.g., questionnaires, stimuli)
- organization and scheduling of participants
- conducting laboratory or online experiments
- communication with participants (email coordination)
- data entry, cleaning, and preparation
- support with literature research
- assistance with public outreach (e.g., girls' day)

- basic knowledge of research methods and statistics
